This year, planning and preparations for the 6th BUHAYANI FESTIVAL and the 158th Dr. Jose P. Rizal Birth Anniversary commemoration started much earlier compared to previous years.

The events committee wanted to make a stronger impact not only aiming for the Pearl Award presented by DOT and ATOP to highly deserving Local Government Units with exemplary festivals, but instilling more deeply the spirit of heroism inspired by Dr. Jose Rizal.

With the Buhayani Festival being in its iron year, the city is highlighting the most well-known of this metal's attributes: strength. As such, even as early as March, numerous sponsors and festival partners have already given their pledges of support for a bigger and stronger Buhayani Festival.

Mayor Timmy Chipeco, the Father of Buhayani Festival, together with the festival committee, added activities to attract more competitors and spectators from a wider sector of our society: CalamBangka for our fisherfolks and those whose livelihood depends on Laguna Lake; Spoken Word Poetry with musical accompaniment for the millennials with their famous hugot lines; and the Kundiman Singing Contest, so that appreciation for our traditional love songs will be revived in the heart of the present generation.

Surprises await participants and guests in this year's Baile sa Bayan ni Pepe, the city's take on the traditional Baile de Gala. Meanwhile, on its 6th year the Buhayani Bike Festival, under the helm of PEPEDAL, promises a more exciting race with the use of the newly established Motocross RaceTrack in Brgy. Bunggo.

Pupils from upland barangays will be given the chance to visit the Museo ni Jose Rizal sa Calamba, where our National Hero and kababayan Dr. Jose Rizal lived. The highlight of the museum visit is the story telling session about the life and works of our other local heroes like BGen. Vicente Lim and Capt. Geronimo M. Aclan. As in the past years, elected officials headed by Mayor Timmy Chipeco and Vice Mayor Ross Rizal will serve as story tellers.

A bigger and better gastronomic experience will be brought to you by the Salu-salo ng Aning Calambeño. More flavorful treats to excite the palate will be brought by the different barangays of the city.

Making a comeback this year is the colourful and high flying Saranggolahan ni Pepe. It will be sure to give the spectators a natural high as they watch beautiful kites cavorting in the sky.

The highlight of the Buhayani Festival is the Dr. Jose P. Rizal Birth Anniversary commemoration on June 19. It will start with the traditional early morning floral offering at five historic monuments of our national hero followed by a program at the Museo ni Rizal sa Calamba. The Symbolic Float Competition with this year's theme "Rizal's Travel" will be in the afternoon. It will also include the Street Dancing Competition and the Biggest Delegation in Rizal Costume. With the numerous activities scheduled this year, the City Government and the Festival Executive Management Committee of the Buhayani Festival are expecting bigger crowds compared to its previous celebrations.

Sayaw-Indak Competition @ BUHAYANI FESTIVAL 2019

GENERAL RULES

- The contest is open to all interested school-based street dance groups in CALAMBA CITY.
- Dance Theme should be based on the colorful culture of Calamba and depict the life and works of Dr. Jose Rizal.
- It is encouraged to use props/materials endemic in Calamba and must feature its scenic beauty.
- No harmful props shall be used like sharp objects, flammable materials and the like.
- The group must have a minimum of 60 and a maximum of 100 members (this excludes nondancers crew, support staff and props men).
- The sequence in the order of parade and dance showdown shall be determined by drawing of lots.
- The music to be used is the Buhayani Theme Song, which will be provided by the City Tourism Office (can be remixed with contemporary music.)
- The Buhayani Festival Organizers will provide each contingent with a P30,000.00 financial assistance to cover transportation and meals during the competition. In case the contingent fails to attend the competition, the full amount shall be returned to the City Government of Calamba.
- Upon registration, each contingent shall provide 2 valid IDs and Tax Identification Number (TIN) of the PAYEE for the check for financial assistance, as well as the prize, should the contingent win.
- Judging shall be divided into two: 70% of the score shall come from the DANCE SHOWDOWN to be held at the Rizal Plaza on a date to be announced by the organizers while 30% shall be scored during the BUHAYANI GRAND PARADE on June 19.
- The Decision of Judges shall be final and executory.
- Unruly behavior, unsportsmanship and disrespect to the judges and organizing committee shall be grounds for disqualification.
- Registration Requirements: Accomplished Registration form with signature of the school head and waiver.
- Deadline of registration and submission of requirements is extended until April 15, 2019 at the City Cultural Affairs, Tourism and Sports Development Office.

GENERAL RULES

- The competition is open to all Calambeños. Only one entry per category is allowed for each Barangay.
- Only registered Fishing Vessels in Boat R Program of DA-BFAR are allowed.
- Crossing the Marker Buoy at the starting line is strictly prohibited and will be a means for disqualification
- No rider is allowed to join if found to be under the influence of alcohol and prohibited drugs.
- Competitors are required to wear proper uniform on and off the race course. A life vest will be provided for the safety of the participants.
- A protest against the participants eligibility to compete in a race shall be advised to Competition committee no later than 1 hour before the race.
- If in case the number of boats/kayaks is less than the number of participants/participating group, the race will be done by batch. The participants/team with the shortest time will be deemed the winner.
- START: Lots shall be drawn to determine the stations of boats at the start. Competitors shall be at the starting area in due time to allow satisfactory preparation for the start. Aligners will make sure that the bows are all positioned in alignment as confirmed by the starter. The starter shall call the attention of the competitors by the words "ATTENTION..." and he shall give a starting signal by a "FLAG or MEGAPHONE". If the competitors start paddling before the signal, he has made a false start. A competitor who make a second false start will be disqualified.
- FINISH: The boat has finished the race when its bow crosses the finish line with all the paddlers in it. If two boats reach the finishing line at the same time, there shall be a re-race between the boats involved.
- Participants must attend the Briefing meeting on June 10, 2019, 2:00 PM at the City Hall, 3rd Floor Lobby.
- Deadline of submission of entry is on May 30 2019, Thursday at City Tourism Office.

MECHANICS:

- The competition is open to all Calambeños in the city's 54 Barangays.
- The competition will be on June 16, 2019, Sunday, at Brgy. Sampiruhan.
- There will be 3 categories:
 - Flat Kite
 - Geometric kites (with box)
 - Figure Kites
- Registration is on the day of the competition, 9 AM to 12 NN. Competition proper will start at 1 PM. Only 20 entries per Category will be accepted. Kites must be locally made. Purchased Kites are not allowed and will be disqualified.
- The size of the kite must be at least 5ft. in diameter.
- All entries must achieve flight capacity to qualify for judging.
- All entries shall be given a 3-minute launch period and maybe retried 3 times. A kite that gets entangled may be flown again with clearance from the organizers.
- If the weather is bad or the winds are too low, the judges may implement the "No Flying Condition Regulations". Under these condition, participating kites will be judged without flying.
- The Organizers will give each group their corresponding entry number to be displayed in the kites at all times.
- Awards will be given to first, second and third place winners. A special award will be given to the Super Kite.
- The judges may disqualify participants who will not observe the rules and regulations set by the organizers.
- The judges' decision will be final and unappealable.

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MECHANICS:

- The Hip Hop dance competition is open to all dance groups with members living or studying in any high school or college in Calamba.
- Each group is shall have a minimum of eight (8) members and maximum of sixteen (16) members and may be composed of all male, all female or a combination of both.
- The group shall perform a maximum of seven (7) minutes routine and. Exceeding the time limit will mean automatic deduction of three (3) points to the group's total score.
- The participating group shall submit their music to the organizer in USB or CD 2 days before the competition. The group name and title of the performance/ musical piece must be printed on the CD. Backup copies of the music shall be kept by the dance group.
- Use of explicit content and lewd lyrics in the dance music are strictly prohibited.
- Lewd dance moves and costumes are strictly prohibited.
- Strictly no stunts. The organizers have the right to stop any performance and disqualify on the spot any group(s) that will perform deadly stunts.
- All participating groups and individuals are required to sign the waiver issued by the organizers that states of the organizers are not liable for any injury and untoward incident that might happen during the event.
- The group shall assign a head/ leader who will coordinate with the organizers regarding contest rules and other concern. He/she shall also ensure that parental consent/assumption of risk has been given for dancers who are minors.
- All participating groups shall be at the competition venue at least 1 hour before the scheduled start of the program.
- The judges' decision shall be final and non-appealable
- The following are strictly not allowed in the performance:
 - The use of real fighting armor (Ex. Sword, knife, guns, arrow, spears, Etc.)
 - The use of any form of liquid (Ex. Blood, oil, water and Alcohol)
 - The use of fire and any pyro techniques and other related materials.
 - Breaking of glass, pots, etc.
 - Dancing naked/und clothed and under the influence of liquor and prohibited drugs.
 - Any competing group found guilty in the violation of the general mechanics shall be subject to disqualification.

3. A sketch/ perspective / artist's illustration of the proposed float must be submitted along with the float entry form and a 200-word description of the float in Filipino language .
4. Float requirements:
 - The maximum height of the float is 11.48 feet or 3.5 meters from the ground level including all decorations.
 - The maximum length of the float is ten (10) meters and its width must not be more than three (3) meters wide.
 - A maximum of 5 persons are allowed to ride on the float (excluding the driver). Each person must play a role in the design and overall concept of the float. No alays or tagapayong please. The driver must be covered with only a small opening for maneuvering.
 - The theme of the float must be posted at the front part, Jose Rizal's 158th birth anniversary at the left and right side, the name of the company/ school/ organization and the Buhayani logo at the back of the float.
 - All floats will receive an entry number which must be displayed and must be plainly visible at the front part of the float.



5. The float must be at the assembly area before 10:00 am for line up and pre-judging.
6. All floats must be able to travel the entire parade route.
7. Participating companies must designate an official representative to attend the meetings/ orientation (to discuss further details of the competition) and to receive the token/award at the stage area during the parade.
8. The winners shall be announced at the conclusion of the parade.

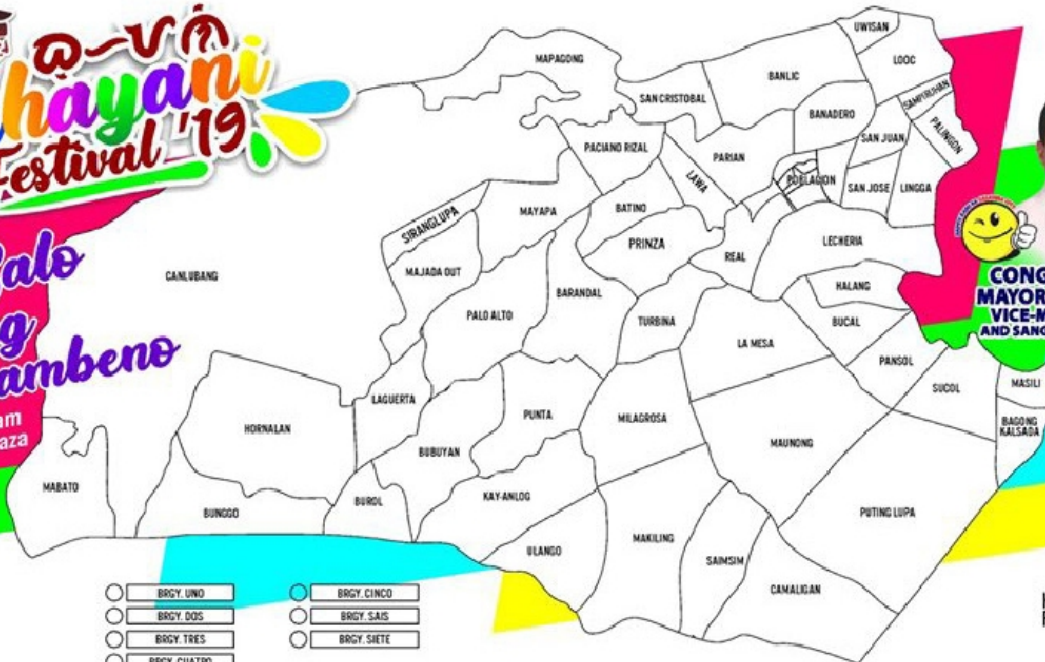

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
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
